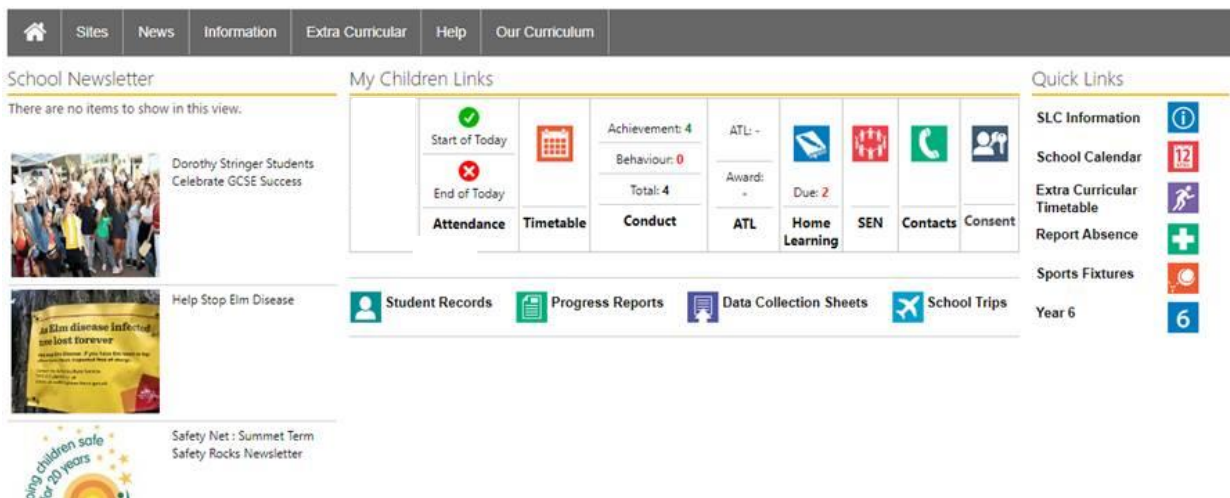


Using the SLG: A summary for parents/carers

Type in www.dorothy-stringer.co.uk into your browser and the following page will appear



Click on login and enter your details. You have already set these up with school and if you cannot remember them please go to **Help** on the web site and click **SLG Logon Reminder**. If you have not yet signed up you will need to complete an application form that is available on the website by clicking **Help** and then selecting **SLG Signup**
