

Dear Parents/Carers

### **Sussex NHS Consent Form for Covid-19 Vaccinations for students aged 12-15**

We are in liaison with the NHS Sussex Immunisation Service to agree exact dates for their team to administer the COVID-19 vaccinations to students at Dorothy Stringer, aged 12-15 year olds, who have completed the NHS consent forms.

The NHS Immunisation Team have indicated that they will be in school on 14 October however they cannot confirm times/dates for individuals until such time as they know the number of students to be vaccinated. Therefore, the deadline for completing consent forms is Wednesday 13 October.

### **Track & Trace**

Some parents and carers have contacted us asking for clarity on self-isolation guidelines for siblings. If a student has been in close contact with someone who is positive, even if it is their sibling who has tested positive, they do not need to isolate. They are able to attend school, but they should continue to test using home testing.

If your child is showing any of the symptoms of COVID, or has a positive Lateral Flow Test, they should book a PCR test and isolate until the result is negative. They do not need to isolate once the result comes back negative and should return to school if they are well enough to do so.
