

Weekly News Update Friday 4 March 2022

Dear Parents and Carers

I am sure many of us will have been watching the dreadful news currently unfolding in Ukraine. Some of our families have relatives still in the country and the pastoral teams have been working with them as well as the rest of the school community to ensure they feel supported. Our assembly this week focussed on the ongoing crisis and some of the history behind the conflict, as well as the support available here in school. A former colleague oversees British Humanitarian Aid, and they are currently working on getting support into Poland, where over half a million people have fled the conflict. As a community we would like to support the Disasters Emergency Committee appeal: <u>Dec Ukraine Appeal</u> who will co-ordinate the response for those who have been displaced.

In brighter news, Tuesday 1 March saw the allocation of our new Year 7 students into Dorothy Stringer. We look forward to welcoming them into our school on Friday 1 July for their induction day and to meeting our new intake parents and carers in person in September. Mr Ward and the new Year 7 team will be visiting our feeder primary schools after Easter to begin the transition process.
