Dear Parents/Carers

This will be the last weekly news of 2021! Next week we will send you the Stringer Press with the highlights from the Autumn Term.

Thank you for all your support over the last thirteen weeks; it has been fantastic seeing the students working hard in the classroom and accessing all the extracurricular activities as well. Our final day of term is Friday 17 December and we close at 12.30. The last day of term will be a Christmas themed jumper/non-uniform day, traditionally on a non-uniform day we ask students to donate a £1 to a collection, however this year we would like to ask for voluntary contributions to our Christmas Appeal so that we can use the money to support families in financial need. We are so grateful to everyone who has donated to our Christmas Appeal so far, the response has been fantastic. When we return in the new year, we have a staggered start as we did in the Autumn to enable us to complete the lateral flow tests for all students before their return to the classroom. This will be especially important as students (and staff) are more likely to have come into contact with a greater number of people over the Christmas break. Students will be tested and if the lateral flow is negative, will return to lessons. Any who test positive will have to take a PCR test.

Students should arrive at the times below (in uniform) and make their way to the main hall for testing. The only exception will be for students who have previously tested positive in the last 90 days; these students should arrive at the same time as their tutor group and then return to class. Students who have not been given permission for testing will be unable to complete a test at school. The testing is not compulsory, but we would encourage students to take the tests to ensure our community stays safe.
