Return to school

This week has all been about welcoming all our students back to school and into the classrooms again. We have managed to use the lateral flow tests for all students in the school (for whom we have consent) and two-year groups have been tested twice. Once students have had three lateral flow tests in school, we will then provide students with a home test kit. We have been so impressed with how our students have conducted themselves and it's good to see them reuniting with their friends. I'd also like to take this opportunity to thank our Testing Team for managing the testing centre so efficiently.

As happened in the autumn term we will again ask that on days where students have a core PE lesson on their timetable, they should attend school in their Dorothy Stringer PE Kit. Students will be allowed stay in their kit after the lesson, or change into their school uniform if they need dry clothes. So, students should still be packing their uniform or spare PE kit on PE days. This practice is aimed at reducing numbers of students using the changing rooms at any one time. If there is any reason that students cannot wear their PE kit to school, then we will be able arrange for them to change in PE. Finally, our excellent PE extra curriculum offer starts up again from 15 March.
